On Tuesday 9th June, pupils are required to come school dressed in their P.E. kits (house colour top, black shorts/black bottoms and trainers). We strongly recommend a sun hat and sunscreen. Each pupil will need a water bottle clearly labelled with their name, as they will be transported from one event to the next.

Parents/Carers are welcome to bring a picnic chair or picnic mat to make themselves comfortable while enjoying the day. A spectator's area will be sectioned off and **we kindly request that adults refrain from walking on the tracks or in the actual competition area.**

- Please limit the size and amount of items you bring onto school grounds.
- A maximum of 3 family members to attend
- You will be issued with a wristband, which must be worn to gain entry.
- Wristbands must be worn throughout the whole day.
- Adults are able to leave the school grounds and re-enter as long as they still have wristbands on. No wristband, no entry!

Lunch Arrangements

Parents/Carers can enjoy a picnic lunch with their child on the day (lunch will be from 12pm-12:30pm). *Please note, alcohol is not permitted onsite and adults will be asked to leave if this requirement is not adhered to.*

If you will not be attending the picnic lunch with your child, they will either require a packed lunch from home or a school packed lunch, which will need to be ordered in advance by Tuesday 2nd June.

(Please note, there will be no hot school dinners on this day).

Children remain the responsibility of their parents/carers during the whole lunch time. Those children whose parents/ carers are unable to attend the picnic will remain with a member of staff in the lunch hall. This ensures that we know where the children are during the lunch hour.

The school day will end at 2:30pm on Tuesday 9th June (unless your child is already booked in to attend After School Club). Children will need to be collected from their usual class collection point.
